Peter Roosenboom is a leading expert in entrepreneurial finance and private equity. He has been an invited speaker at influential conferences and seminars in the private equity industry and has advised the Dutch government on private equity and the financing of small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs). His advice has been the cornerstone of several changes in government policy recently. He is also well-connected to the private equity industry at the European level as a member of the Independent Governing Body of the Private Equity Research Exchange Platform (PEREP; www.perepanalytics.eu) established by the European Venture Capital and Private Equity Association (EVCA). He is also a member of the Advisory Board of Equidam (www.equidam.com), a company specialized in the valuation of start-up businesses. Recently he has also been invited to join the Advisory Board of MKB Multifonds (www.mkbmultifonds.nl), a fund-of-funds investing in private equity funds targeted towards Dutch SMEs.

His research is interdisciplinary in nature and has been published in finance, accounting and management journals.
